

**5-Speed Manual.** Remaining true to its European roots, the Elantra Touring is equipped with a sporty 5-speed manual transmission. A 4-speed automatic is optional for those who'd prefer to simply press the gas and go.

**Smart Power.** The Elantra Touring features such fuel-saving technologies as motor-driven power steering, matched to its 2.0L, 16-valve DOHC engine. Its low-set engine idle reduces emissions and helps increase fuel economy.



**Fun and fuel-efficient.** Its looks may be what draw you in, but its performance will make you commit. Spirited and fuel-efficient, the Elantra Touring's 2.0L, 138 hp, 16-valve DOHC, 4-cylinder Continuously Variable Valve Timing (CVVT) engine employs some of the most advanced technologies and provides maximum fuel efficiency while meeting the demands of both city and highway driving. Built for fun-filled adventure, the Elantra Touring is even more fuel-efficient on the highway with steering wheel-mounted cruise control (not available on L). A MacPherson strut front suspension and multi-link rear suspension ensure responsive performance.









**Airbags.** Standard dual front airbags, available driver and front passenger side-impact airbags, along with side-curtain airbags for front and rear outboard passengers (not available on L), offer peace of mind on any road.

#### **Anti-Lock Braking System.**

ABS helps prevent wheel lock-up and helps maintain steering control during emergency braking situations by rapidly pulsing the brakes, allowing you to manoeuvre around objects ahead (ABS not available on L).

**Travel in Safety. Travel in Style.** Combining steel side-impact door beams with front and rear crumple zones, your best interests are put first with Hyundai's intelligent safety body construction. In addition to an available Anti-lock Braking System (ABS) with Electronic Brake Force Distribution (EBD) and available Electronic Stability Control (ESC)<sup>2</sup>, Elantra Touring offers an available 6 airbags<sup>1</sup>. Parents will appreciate the Lower Anchor Tethers for Children (LATCH) System, and the Child Restraint System (CRS) (upper tether anchors) with rear child safety locks. Front active head restraints (not available on L) and an energy-absorbing steering column work with front-seat pretensioners and force limiters for increased levels of safety.



We believe that if we continue to follow the principles behind what is smart, we'll continue to show Canadians that Hyundai is the right choice today and their best choice for the future.










